Maximum guests for Civil Ceremony/ Partnership indoors	60 – this is for fire regulations, rather than space
Maximum guests for Civil Ceremony/ Partnership outdoors	The ceremony can take place on the Nibley House steps (the ceremonial words have to be said just inside), so the numbers are unlimited – weather permitting
Maximum guests for Wedding Breakfast indoors	60 (seated) or 80 (buffet)
Maximum guests for marquee	150 (marquee on front lawn) or consult Walter Eley for the possibility of hosting 200 (marquee in side garden). If larger parties are required, marquees can be set up in adjacent fields.
Venue Hire Charge	£1200 from 1st Jan 2010
Civil Ceremony Charge	£250
Price structure (see also Venue Tariff)	Flat rate Venue Hire Charge + Civil ceremony/partnership charge (if applicable) + Food and drink per person + Your other costs (marquee, flowers, photographer etc)
Exclusive use	Nibley House always has exclusive use: you have the run of the house and gardens for the duration of your event

Hall	20ft x 20ft (all 3 rooms are sited together at the front of the house)
Legal restrictions on use	No smoking indoors No fireworks No amplified music to be played outside after 8pm Parties must end at midnight
